2023 ANNUAL SALA EXHIBITION ENTRY CONDITIONS

- 1. All Exhibitors must be Full Members of The Burnside Painting Group who have paid their annual Membership fees in full prior to Submitting and Exhibiting works. All works must be for sale.
- 2. Paintings must be the artist's original work, not copies of another person's art work or photographs of their art work. (Copyright Laws must not be breached).
- 3. All works will be subject to selection. For unaccepted works, the artist will be notified on Selection Day.
- 4. Works will be displayed in two sections where the following conditions will apply:
- 4.1 Works for Hanging: Maximum size including frame no larger than 1.2 square meters.
- (a) Framed and ready for hanging to accepted professional standard including D-Rings (see below).
- (b) Unframed (i.e. wooden stretcher), with hanging facility to accepted professional standard.
- 4.2 Works for Screen Display: (without frame or hanging device).

Works on paper, of uniform size, smaller than A3, fixed to a standard cream-coloured mount of good quality and clean. Mounts are available at the Burnside Painting Group Hall for \$7 ea. or 3 for \$20.

There are four display sizes available (inside window measure): 310 x 220mm, 290 x 200mm, 270 x 180mm, and 210 x 150mm - NO other mounts or display sizes are acceptable.

- 5. Artists may submit up to 2 pictures for hanging, and up to 3 mounted pictures for screen display.*
- 6. All works must be dry with the artist signature or mark clearly visible somewhere on the painting.
- 7. Entry Fees: All Works attract a \$7.00 entry fee for each piece accepted.
- 8. Artists Name, Award Category, Title of Work, Medium and Price must be legibly noted on the back lower right corner of the work using the labels provided by the Exhibition Committee. Mixed media works should be entered in the predominant category.
- 9. Paintings must be delivered with completed entry form, labels and entry fees at the times advertised.
- 10. Insurance for members' works is not provided by The Burnside Painting Group. All reasonable care is taken, but The Burnside Painting Group does not accept responsibility for any damage or loss.
- 11. The Burnside Painting Group will take a 20% commission on any paintings sold.



The following are examples of suitable D-Rings to be used for all hanging works. These should be attached to the back of each side of your work, approx. one-third from the top of your painting. Proper picture hanging wire must also be affixed.
